1 INTRODUCTION

Africa Oil SA Corp, Ricocure (Pty) Ltd and Azinam Limited (a wholly owned subsidiary of Eco Atlantic) (the Joint Venture Partners of the Block 3B/4B Exploration Right - hereafter jointly referred to as the Applicants) have appointed Environmental Impact Management Services (Pty) Ltd (EIMS) as the Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) to assist with undertaking the required authorisation processes (including the statutory public participation), and to compile and submit the required documentation in support of application for:

- Environmental Authorisation (EA) in accordance with the NEMA- Listed activity 18 (GNR 984)

The Applicants are the holders of an existing Exploration Right for Block 3B/4B in terms of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act (No. 28 of 2002 – MPRDA), as amended. The licence block covers an area of approximately 11 100 km² and is situated between latitudes 31°S and 33°S on the continental shelf in water depths ranging from 200 m to 2 000 m. The applicant is the operator and holder of an existing Exploration Right for Block 3B/4B in terms of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act (No. 28 of 2002 – MPRDA), as amended. The licence block covers an area of approximately 11 100 km², and is situated between latitudes 31°S and 33°S on the continental shelf in water depths ranging from 200 m to 2 000 m.

Block 3B/4B is located approximately 120 km west of St Helena Bay and approximately 145 km south-west of Hondeklip Bay off the West Coast of South Africa. The area of primary interest is in the north of this block, but this could also cover other areas in future. As part of the process of applying for the Exploration Right, the applicant undertook and completed the reprocessing project covering 2 000 km², which is a subset of the 10 000 km² BHP/Shell 3D seismic datasets, focussed primarily on the most northern portion of Block 3B/4B. Based on analysis of the reprocessed 3D dataset, the JV Partners are now proposing to drill an exploration well in the area of primary interest in order to fully appraise the hydrocarbon potential of the geological structure or “prospect”. In the event that the well is successful, it is envisaged that up to four additional wells could be drilled.

2 OBJECTIVES OF THE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

South Africa, being one of the countries with the most progressive constitutions, enshrined the public's right to be involved in decisions that may affect them in its Constitution. Section 57(1) of the new Constitution that provides: "*The National Assembly may (b) make rules and orders concerning its business, with due regard to representative and participatory democracy, accountability, transparency and public involvement*". This provision, along with several others gave rise to many new trends in South African legislation. In environmental legislation, the idea of public participation (or stakeholder engagement) features strongly and especially the National Environmental Management Act (Act 107 of 1998, NEMA) and the recent regulations passed under the auspices of this Act makes very strict provisions for public participation in environmental decision-making.

Public participation can be defined as..."*a process leading to a joint effort by stakeholders, technical specialists, the authorities and the proponent who work together to produce better decisions than if they had acted independently*"¹. From this definition, it can be seen that the input of the public is regarded as very important indeed.

The Public Participation Process (PPP) is designed to provide sufficient and accessible information to Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) in an objective manner to assist them to:

- During the Scoping and EIA Process:
 - Contribute relevant local information and knowledge to the environmental assessment;
 - Verify that their issues have been recorded;
 - Comment on the findings of the environmental assessments; and

- Provide relevant local information and knowledge to the environmental assessment.

The PPP is a requirement of several pieces of South African Legislation and aims to ensure that all relevant I&APs are consulted, involved and their opinions are taken into account and a record included in the reports submitted to Authorities. The process ensures that all stakeholders are provided this opportunity as part of a transparent process which allows for a robust and comprehensive environmental study. The PPP for the necessary authorisation required for the proposed TGS Reconnaissance BA Project needs to be managed sensitively and according to best practises in order to ensure and promote:

- Compliance with international best practice options;
- Compliance with national legislation;
- Establishment and management of relationships with key stakeholder groups; and
- Encouragement of involvement and participation in the environmental study and authorisation/approval process.

As such, the purpose of the PPP and stakeholder engagement process is to:

- Introduce the proposed project and process for the authorisation project;
- Explain the environmental authorisation;
- Determine and record issues, concerns, suggestions, and objections to the project;
- Provide opportunity for input and gathering of local knowledge;
- Establish and formalise lines of communication between the I&APs and the project team;
- Identify all significant issues for the project; and
- Identify possible mitigation measures or environmental management plans to minimise and/or prevent negative environmental impacts and maximise and/or promote positive environmental impacts associated with the project.

This Public Participation Report (PPR) lists all verbal and written issues raised by I&APs and stakeholders from the 30-day initial notification and call to register period from the 12 June 2023 to date. A breakdown of the PPP is given within the remaining sections of this PPR.

2.1 LEGAL COMPLIANCE

The PPP must comply with all environmental legislation that requires public participation as part of an application for authorisation or approval; namely:

- NEMA;

Adherence to the requirements of the above-mentioned Acts will allow for an Integrated PPP to be conducted, and in so doing, satisfy the requirement for public participation referenced in the Acts. The details of the Integrated PPP are provided below.

An initial I&AP database has been compiled from historic projects in the area, desktop based I&AP identification and newspaper advertisements to obtain the contact details of the potentially affected I&APs. The I&APs referred to in the PPR include:

Woodstock family go head-to-head with City

IN A David and Goliath battle, a Woodstock family have launched a constitutional challenge against the City for wanting to issue them with emergency housing kits as they face eviction from premises they have called home for 25 years.

The family are being represented by Urban Land Justice and advocacy NPO Ndifuna Ukwazi Law Centre (NU), which said the building was sold to a private developer.

In the application, the family are asking the court to declare the policy of issuing emergency housing materials without access to land unconstitutional and to direct the City, in collaboration with national and provincial governments, to investigate vacant publicly owned buildings and land for emergency housing.

According to the NPO, since 1998 the family's now deceased father had been the caretaker of the building, where he oversaw maintenance and security, and in exchange for his work he did not receive a salary but was granted permission by the previous owners to live on the property with his family.

NU said: "Because all the family members have low incomes and have no other housing alternatives, the City is constitutionally obliged to provide emergency accommodation in terms of the Emergency Housing Programme. The City is notoriously known for creating relocation camps in places like Wolwerivier, Blikkiesdorp and Kampies for evictees.

"The City has, however, revealed that all emergency accommodation

Safa vows to beef up security after two coaches killed in Khayelitsha

INCREASED security measures will be put in place during football games after two coaches were shot and killed in Khayelitsha.

Former Chippa United and Royal AM head coach Mike Lukhubene and another coach yet to be identified were shot dead at about 5.50pm at the Site C Sports Complex.

Police spokesperson Wesley Twigg said Lingeluthu West police registered two counts of murder following a shooting incident at a soccer stadium.

He said two men, aged 37 and 46, were shot dead.

"According to reports the victims were approached by unknown gunmen who shot them. They sustained gunshot wounds to their heads and were declared deceased on the scene by paramedics," said Twigg.

He said the motive for the attack had yet to be determined and the suspects who had fled were yet to be arrested.

Safa Cape Town president Bennett Bailey said the sporting fraternity were in shock after two officials were attacked after the Coke-Cola Cup tournament. The game was between Hot Spurs from Nyanga and Tottenham Hotspur FC from Manenberg.

"It is important to note that when the incident happened the game was over. Most of the officials had already left the facility. Our heartfelt condolences to the two families. Not only is the incident regrettable, but unfortunate it happened at the sports field. We have gone this far as Safa Cape Town to take the Coke Cup games to outlying areas with the objective of wanting to make sure football is being played at the highest level at all facilities."

Informal traders raise troubles at summit

THE 2023 Informal Sector Summit and Expo concluded with commitments and many concerns for informal traders who seek lasting solutions to safety, transport, storage space and out-of-touch policies.

Business associations and informal traders from different communities braved the wet and cold weather yesterday to attend the engagements in hopes of receiving answers to their daily struggles.

South African Informal Traders' Alliance president, Roscheda Muller said the summit offered the City a chance, not only to hear their challenges, but also to support their visions and proposals.

"In the past we always walked away with the fact that it was a talk-shop, however, the most important action that was implemented after last year's summit was that we would have regular area management committee meetings and that happened. However, the meetings were not that fruitful for an example we used to operate by the DHL Stadium and were evicted when it was built and promised to be returned.

"About 12 years later we are still talking about the same issue. There is also an issue with infrastructure including storage for traders, safety, toilets and dignified places to trade. Although the City says it's here for us and wants to work with us we don't really feel the partnership on the ground. So we are waiting with bated breath for the implementation of our needs that we presented today," said Muller.

A Khayelitsha trader who sells vetkoek and asked not to be named for fear of safety, said different sectors also need to work together and tackle extortion.

She also requested the City to make it easy to access tenders by training and deploying officials to educate them, especially the elderly.

Philippi Development Forums' Bukwela Sonamzi, who is also the owner of Women Healing Space which operates around Crossroads in Nyanga said: "There is a very big disconnect between the policies and by-laws. The policies introduced may be working for the City but not for the people on the ground. That is why we have so many challenges, for example when one goes to City offices an official will tell you that if you have problems with services go to sub-council or refer you to the by-laws. Also the City is not holding sub-councils accountable. We are also not treated the same in different communities which also creates conflicts."

Mayco member for economic growth James Vos said among the programmes they have launched was an Index which will track ten critical indicators of business-facing services, with a special focus on enabling greater infrastructure investment and economic growth in Cape Town.

"The indicators include electricity and water connections, building plan approvals, and informal trading permits.

"We are on a journey of culture change in the City to make our government much more efficient, responsive and digitally accessible. The Economic Growth Directorate is planning on spending around R100m on capital works on the City's strategic economic assets and informal trading infrastructure.

"This means funding more capacity building, streamlining trader-facing services such as our e-permitting system, and growing a pipeline of infrastructure projects," he said.

Executive director of Enterprise and Investment in the Economic Growth Directorate Lance Greyling said they noted all concerns and requested patience while trying to address them.



Another aim was to link the rail, bus, MyCiTi, and even the minibus taxi services to a single ticketing system so that commuters could use one card for all public transport services, and a tender process for that was under way, he said.

Europe had no idea what it was like dealing with the problems posed by the minibus taxi industry, and the managing director of Lagos's transport authority, Abimbola Akinajo, whom Mr Quintas said was "militant" about minibus operators in the Nigerian city, had been astounded that Cape Town

spent so much effort negotiating with the taxi industry.

Mr Quintas said he had also been met with wide-eyed looks when he had described how he and his bodyguards had been caught up in a shootout during an attempted hijacking last month.

Mr Quintas said two Cape Town taxi bosses had been killed during the week he had been away.

And before that, on Thursday May 4, popular taxi boss Charmaine Bailey, 53, who had been in the taxi industry for about a decade, had been gunned down after attending a Wynberg Taxi Association meeting.

Clean-up volunteers hit the beach for World Ocean Day

Volunteers from around the city cleared plastic, stompies and other litter from Hout Bay Beach for World Ocean Day, on Thursday June 8.

The event was organised by Cape Town Beach Clean-up, a non-profit organisation that holds beach clean-ups on the first Saturday of each month.

Its founder Gregory Player, of Milnerton, told those gath-

ered at the Mariner's Wharf end of the beach that a UCT study had found that by 2050 there would be more plastic in the sea than fish although some predicted it could happen sooner, and it was estimated that about 8 million metric tons of plastic waste entered the oceans each year.

The clean-ups were a way for families to spend time together while also doing something good for the planet, and businesses could get staff involved,

he said.

Mr Player encouraged people to complain on social media about litter and dumping and to tag their councillors.

Included in the event were 3km and 12km runs and 250m, 750m and 1500m swims.

Despite City staff having cleaned the beach the previous day, volunteers still managed to collect 94kg of litter in 20 recycling bags. They also found a ring, car keys, tyre and a disused inflatable mattress.
