Young gaming sensation, Sbusiso Monyebudi, known online as ‘Nofear_ggs77,’ has returned from a major EAFC tournament where his promising run ended in round 16. Both Sbusiso and his coach, Humphrey Gokoane, said the experience has only strengthened their mission going forward. Sbusiso, reflecting on his performance, said, “We got knocked out at round 16, but we learned a lot. I wanted to go further, but I’m proud of the effort.” His coach, Humphrey, echoed that sentiment, “Getting knocked out in the 16th round doesn’t take anything away from the work he put in,” he said. “He fought hard, he stayed composed, and he represented eMalahleni with pride.”

Sbusiso’s journey with gaming began early, after receiving a PlayStation 2 from his father. “I was about 12 when I started playing,” he said. “Whenever I played, my heart became at ease. For that moment, I forget about everything; I just focus on gaming.”

At 24, with an advanced diploma in computer science and working as an intern support engineer, Sbusiso once dreamed of going fully professional. “I had a dream to play EAFC professionally,” he said. “But because of time constraints and my other commitments, I had to put that dream on hold and focus on having a better life.” His coach believes that the dream is still within reach. “The door isn’t closed,” Humphrey said. “He has the talent. He just needs the right opportunity.”

Humphrey explained, “Mbali Gaming Hub is a place where kids come to play games. It’s a safe place for children. We are introducing gaming to township kids. I’m bringing the world of gaming to Mpumalanga. We are going.” Humphrey added, “We’re giving kids a place to stay safe, to learn, and to dream. What we’re building is bigger than just gaming.” Despite the tournament exit, both remain determined. Sbusiso said, “We are going.” His coach concluded, “And we are not stopping.”

The site is approximately 5km North West of eMalahleni Central Business District. The centre point of the site is 25°51'09.01"S; 29° 09'52.59"E.
Activity:	The Applicant proposes the Char Technology VCN Project, which entails the addition of a Vanadium Carbon Nitride (VCN) furnace onto the existing licensed facility. The facility currently operates under an approved AEL with reference number NDM/AEL/MP312/13/06. The proposed VCN furnace will not be newly constructed on site but will be assembled and installed on the existing structural footprint, requiring minor refurbishment of current structures. The introduction of the new furnace constitutes a Listed Activity and represents a change to the approved operational processes; accordingly, an amendment to the existing AEL will be required to authorise the proposed activity.

EIMS will be following the procedures defined in the EIA Regulations for undertaking a Basic Assessment process.
